

2017 SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM
Northbrook School District 28

The Northbrook 28 summer school program offers a wide variety of enrichment opportunities for students of all grade levels. We are offering four class periods of summer school from 9:00a.m. until 12:55p.m. All classes will be 55 minutes in length. **Please note: your son or daughter should be enrolled in classes that reflect the grade he or she will be entering in the 2017-2018 school year.** For example, if your child is currently a third grader, you would enroll him or her in classes designated as a fourth grade class. **Summer school registration will be open to residents of Northbrook School District 28, 27,& 31 this year. Residents of District 27 & 31 will be charged a \$10 surcharge for each class.**

Summer school will take place at Northbrook Junior High School. Classes begin Monday, June 12th, and continue through Friday, July 7th, 2017. (no Summer School on July 3rd & 4th.) **The dates are subject to change if additional emergency days are used in the district.** The cost per class is \$105, and some classes have **additional lab fees.**

You will find online registration is on our District website under Programs/Summer School. Click the "button" on the page and it will connect you to Active Network, the district online registration system. Registration will begin for District 28 on March 6th at 10:00a.m. and for District 27 & 31 begin on March 20th at 8:00am. Registration ends for all students on April 21st at noon. No late registrations will be accepted. Please keep your confirmation, as it is your class schedule for summer school. Tuition is non-refundable except in the case of class cancellation. Some classes are very popular and fill up fast, so please register as soon as possible.

Classes marked with *asterisk in Period 4 are designated as being a "snack" class and your child can bring a snack into those classes. During summer school, we cannot guarantee an allergy-free environment. Due to student allergies, we are requesting that children refrain from bringing any peanut products to summer school, including peanut butter sandwiches, granola bars, trail mix, etc. Please note our one food class Cooking, we cannot guarantee an allergy free environment. If your child is not enrolled in a "snack" class you may not bring in food into school. Please see our District 28 snack guidelines for more information.

Summer band and orchestra lessons will be offered at the Junior High for District 28 students but are not part of the summer school program. Please contact an Instrumental Music Director at (847) 498-7920 before registering your child for summer school. Doing so will allow coordination of lessons and summer school classes. Please remember your child must be enrolled in consecutive classes with no breaks in their schedule.

If your child will be absent from summer school, we request that you notify the summer school office by calling 847-498-7920 and leaving a message at any time. Attendance is taken in each class period and your help with this will ensure that all students arrive to school safely.

Throughout summer school, **photos and/or videos of students** are included in District publications, on the District's website and on District-administered social media. Images or videos of students may be used in electronic, video, or printed form. From time to time, news and other organizations may include photos and videos of students in their publications and on their television stations and/or websites. Occasionally, news outlets may publish students' first and last names. If you do not want your child to be featured in these types of pieces, please notify the Summer School Director in writing before the beginning of summer school.
