CLASSES FOR GRADES 5-6: Enrichment Classes

Babysitting Class, Grade 5-8 Period 1 & 2 (Lab fee \$20) (please note: classes have expanded grade levels)

This class is designed to teach babysitting, leadership skills and basic first aid skills in a fun and informative way. Students will know how to care for infants, toddlers and older children through video, workbook activities, discussion, and role play.

Beginning Ukulele/Keyboard, Grade 5-8 Period 2 (Lab fee \$5) Max Enrollment - 20 students (please note: class has expanded grade level)

The class is for the students who are interested in learning the foundational skills on ukulele and keyboard. Students will work in large groups or individually. By the end of class, students will play a lot of different songs and will have the tools to continue on their own! No prior experience needed, all levels welcome. Ukulele/keyboards will be provided. Students are welcome to bring their own ukulele if they prefer.

Beginning Woodworking Grade 5-6 Period 1 & 3 (Lab fee \$35) Max Enrollment - 16 students

Incoming 5th and 6th graders will learn the basic usage and safety of HAND TOOLS including a coping saw, file, sanding block, and cordless drill. Some small machines may be used such as the scroll saw, spindle sander, Dremel engraver, and drill press. All activities will be demonstrated and supervised by Mr. Caris, the current Woodworking teacher at NBJH. Students will choose a project from a beginner list. Other projects will be available if time permits. Project choices include a can lamp, small cutting board, name block, or tombstone clock.

Bring out the Singer in you! Grade 5-8 Period 1 (please note: class has expanded grade level)

Do you like to sing and are shy to perform in front of people? This class is for you! The class is designed for the students who like to sing on their own or in a small group setting. The class will focus on learning songs from different musical genres (ex. pop, Broadway). The students will learn techniques to prepare them for auditions with the use of microphones.

Calligraphy, Grades 5-8 Period 3 (Lab fee \$20)

Students will review basic cursive writing, learn the history of the Art of Calligraphy and learn strokes and different styles of Calligraphy. The students will then use their learned technique to make projects. Students will receive their own Calligraphy Fountain Pen and practice note pad. There will also be various colored Calligraphy markers and pens for the students to use.

Caudill Book Club, Grade 5-6 Period 2 (Lab fee \$10)

If you enjoy reading award-winning books, having discussions about your reading with friends, and using technology, look no further than Book Club Class! We will read a 2019 Rebecca Caudill nominee novel together, discuss the story, and use different types of technology to create different projects about the novel. When we've finished the book you will create your own book trailer!

CLASSES FOR GRADES 5-6: Enrichment Classes continued

Computer Science & Coding Grade 5-6 Period 2 & 3, Grade 6-8 Period 4 Max Enrollment: 20 Students (please note: Period 4 class has expanded grade level starting with 6 grade)

We will be using a Google's CS First program to create, animate, and play while learning all about Computer Science & Coding. There will also be opportunities to play with robots and other tools to help us create with our computers. Students will have the opportunity to grow in their knowledge no matter how much or how little experience they have.

Cooking, Grade 5-6 Periods 2 & 4 (Lab fee \$25) Max Enrollment: 20 Students

New recipes will be taught while providing cooking instruction, reading recipes, and preparing foods. Emphasis of this class will be on the benefits of cooking and enjoying healthy foods.

Creative Speaking, Grade 5-8 Period 2 (please note: class has expanded grade level)

Do you get nervous speaking in front of people? Work on your self-confidence while having fun at the same time! We'll do warm ups, and a variety of speech activities, which will make you look forward to presenting in front of the class!

Creative Writing, Grade 5-6 Period 4*

Students will engage in a variety of experimental exercises that will enable them to express themselves in fresh and unique ways.

Cursive Writing, Grade 5-8 Period 1 (Lab fee \$5) (please note: class has expanded grade levels)

Join us to learn & review the art of cursive writing. Students will have the opportunity to practice cursive letters and text with a variety of formats and writing utensils. Students will learn letters and how to connect them. This class will help you to develop your own personal style of handwriting.

Games, Grade 5-8 Period 1, 2, 3, & 4* (please note: classes have expanded grade levels)

This class will provide an opportunity to learn and participate in games that promote teamwork. The class will emphasize sportsmanship and fun. Join us to play a variety of games.

Girls Just Want to Have Fun, Grade 5-6 Period 4 (Lab fee \$20)

This class combines fun, friendship, fashion and fitness. Students will participate in a variety of activities including fashion drawing, card making, scrapbooking and yoga-lite.

Jewelry Making, Grade 5-6 Period 2 (Lab fee \$20)

Learn how to make bracelets, anklets, earrings and necklaces using different threading techniques. Each week we will focus on a different piece of jewelry.

CLASSES FOR GRADES 5-6: Enrichment Classes continued

Let's Put on A Musical, Grade 5-8 Period 3-4* (Lab fee \$30) This class runs during Period 3 & 4 consecutively

This class will expose students to the process that goes into producing and presenting a musical. This includes singing, dancing, acting and the technical aspects of lights, sound, props and costumes. This class is a two-hour class that run Period 3 & 4. ***The students who are enrolled in this class will need to available to perform with the class the last week of summer school.***

Mindfulness, Grade 5-8 Period 4 *

Mindfulness means paying attention, on purpose. Through this class, students will gain an understanding of how to be present in the current moment, use their breath to increase emotional well-being, and cope with challenges such as stress/anxiety. As a group, we will explore creating a meditation space, eliminating negative influences from our lives, and using effective communication strategies. Students will work with the National Social Emotional Learning Standards through activities such as gratitude journaling, mindful movement, meditation, group sharing, and creative writing exercises. The key to developing a mindfulness practice is finding what strategies work for

Math Games, Grade 5-6 Period 1 & 3 & Grade 5-8 Period 4*

(please note: period 4 class has expanded grade levels)

Need to brush up, catch up or keep up on math skills? Review math concepts and skills through individualized instruction, games, and lots of fun hands-on activities. This class is great for students who need a little extra practice over the summer. We will focus on concepts learned throughout the school year and students will gain confidence and a greater love for math all while having fun learning!

Photoshop Elements and Digital Photography, Grade 5-6 Period 1 (Lab fee \$15) Max Enrollment - 20 Students

Learn the basics of digital photography and take better photos with your device or camera. Learn how to use the tools in Photoshop software to edit digital photos and create unique digital art in an amazing way!

Plant it, Eat it, and Love it! Grade 5-6 Period 1 (Lab fee \$20) Max Enrollment - 18 Students

Dig into our district vegetable garden this summer. Students will participate in planting, harvesting and tasting vegetables. This class will include nutrition, study of plants, ecology and garden-themed crafts. Students will also help run an on-site farmer's market where they will harvest and sell vegetables from the garden.

Scrapbooking, Grade 5-6 Period 2 & Grade 5-8 Period 3 (Lab fee: \$20)

CLASSES FOR GRADES 5-6: Enrichment Classes continued

**Sew as it May Seam Grade 5-8 - Period 1 & 2 (Lab fee \$35) Max Enrollment - 14 students
(please note: classes have expanded grade level)**

In this class, students will learn the basic techniques of sewing which include operating a sewing machine and reading a sewing pattern. Students will get to work on three projects throughout this course.

Theatre Games, Grade 5-8 Period 1 (please note: class has expanded grade level)

This class will provide practice of basic acting skills through fun & engaging theatre games. Regardless of your acting ability, you can work on body movement, voice, and concentration while having fun at the same time!

Time for Tech, Grade 5-6 Period 4 Max Enrollment - 20 Students

Do you love using technology? Come join us for some screen-based learning and fun! This is the perfect class for the student who loves technology, being creative, and trying out new learning resources and skills. We will use technology tools such as iPads and computers to learn lots of different things from creating projects, using new tools, and learning.

CLASSES FOR GRADES 5-6: Athletic Classes

Boys' Basketball, Grade 5-6 Period 2

This class will develop student's basketball skills through practice and games. Students will work on skill development, game play, teamwork, and offer a variety of opportunities for player improvement. Scrimmages and tournaments will be a big part of the class to give students authentic opportunities.

Co-Ed Floor Hockey, Grade 5-6 Period 1

Hockey fundamentals as well as game strategy, teamwork, sportsmanship, and safety are stressed each week. We will start with skills and drills, and then progress to games.

Co-Ed Volleyball Grade 5-6 Period 1

This class will provide individual practice of volleyball skills along with team play. Each class will begin with a review of skills and proceed to the introduction of new concepts and game strategies. This class is designed for newcomers as well as the more experienced player.

Girls' Basketball, Grade 5-8 Period 4*

Student will learn skills, such as proper shooting form, passing, ball handling, rebounding, pivoting, and defensive positioning. Students will participate in drills, shooting games, scrimmages and round robin tournaments to help develop these skills. Students will be divided up by grade level groupings when appropriate.

CLASSES FOR GRADES 5-6: Athletic Classes

Fitness Class, Grade 5-8 Period 3 & Grade 5-6 Period 4* Max Enrollment - 20 Students

(Please note: Period 3 class has expanded grade levels)

Students will explore a wide variety of exercises that are challenging yet fun! This class will consist of multiple stations where students engage in exploratory learning using weights, jump ropes, exercise balls, medicine balls, fitness bands, multiple I-pad fitness applications, kettle bells, speed ladders, and much more! We will work on introducing new exercises that are safe and fun to help keep students wanting to live a healthy, proactive lifestyle.

Soccer, Grade 5-6 Period 3, Grade 5-8 Period 4* (Please note: Period 4 class has expanded grade levels)

Students will work on & develop soccer skills, learn rules and concepts, and gain playing experience. Team play and strategy will be emphasized.

Ultimate Sports, Grade 5-6 Period 4*

Students will explore a wide variety of diamond and field sports. We will play Kick Ball, Whiffle Ball, Frisbee, and so much more. Come experience what Ultimate Sports is all about.

Yoga, Grade 5-8 Period 3

This class will introduce students to a variety of basic yoga styles, with an emphasis on breathing, flexibility, and balance. The goal will be to develop a low-impact practice to enhance sports performance, dance, and overall agility by connecting yoga to relaxation, internal and external awareness and self-acceptance. Parents are invited to join us on the last day for a Parent-Child yoga class. Participants will need to bring their own mat, which they may leave in the classroom for the duration of the summer session.
